

Junior Inter League Rules update I.K. Jones and P Scott. 19.11.15

- 1 Competition to be played on a date and area selected by the Executive Committee.
- 2 Competition to be organised by the County Competition Secretary
- 3 All teams must arrive at venue by 9:30am  
Competition to commence no later than 10:00am Teams for this event will be current playing members of their respective leagues.
- 4 All junior teams must be accompanied by an Adult who has got a current DBS certificate.
- 5 Teams to consist of 6 players from a named list of 8 players.
- 6 Each team to appoint a non playing captain.
- 7 All leagues may submit at least one team, if required number of teams is not reached all leagues may enter another team/teams
- 8 Teams must be submitted to County Competition Secretary at least seven days prior to the competition date.
- 9 Team Captain will submit to the officer in charge on the day of the event the playing order of his/her team.
- 10 This list must be submitted no later than 9:45am.
- 11 Dress code must be adhered to :BCGBA Rules apply :
- 12 Black/Grey trousers, League Shirt or plain collared shirt.
- 13 Competition limited to 16 teams. If more teams entered then a draw will take place.
- 14 All Games will start off 3 except for all home bowlers.  
Home Bowlers handicap of 2
- 15 No practice will be allowed on selected greens 7 days prior to the matches taken place(this excludes league, competition friendlies or cup games)
- 16 In every match, the toss of a coin will determine the even cast of the jacks.
- 17 Players should report to the green manager or referee when called, if called player is unable to play when called the respective league may replace said player with a nominated member of the squad.
- 18 In each match(after all six players have played)the team with the highest aggregate will be declared the winner and awarded two points .In case of a draw one point will be awarded to both teams.
- 19 After completion of the 3<sup>rd</sup> round robin matches the teams with the most points will be declared the group winners and progress to the finals. Runners Up will progress to Consolation Final.(All dependant on how many teams are entered)
- 20 In the case of a tie in the groups/ semi final /final the following order of elimination shall apply.
  - 1 Tie on aggregate the team with the most winners
  - 2 If still a tie the team with the best winner.
  - 3 If still a tie the 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3rd, 4th best winner etc.In the event of a group of three, the following playing order shall apply, the first named teams shall play first, Second Match shall be between losing team from the first tie and the non-playing team. Third match shall be between winners of the first match and the non playing team from first round.
- 21 If 2 greens are used the finals will be played on a third green.
- 22 Qualified Referee to be supplied for the finals

- 23 Host League to provide a buffet for players and officials for presentation of trophies.  
Trophies to be presented by County President.
- 24 Green Managers and Measurers to be provided by host league.
- 25 All Green Managers must be suitably dressed i.e. dark trousers and plain shirt with a collar  
Dress Code applies.
- 26 Venues to be rotated annually within Shropshire County Leagues that participate.
- 27 If a league entered doesn't take part there will be a £30 fine which would go to charity and league would not be allowed to host the following year
